



SAFETY NOTICES

Warning

- ⚠ Ensure the power supply is switched off, or that PoE power is disabled, during installation.
- ⚠ A falling camera can cause injury. During installation ensure the camera is attached securely to the surface.
- ⚠ Do not dismantle the device or attempt repairs yourself. Repairs must be done by IndigoVision representatives.
- ⚠ Ensure that the power supply conforms to the SELV (Safety Extra Low Voltage) safe level.
- ⚠ Risk of explosion if battery is replaced by an incorrect type. Dispose of used batteries according to the instructions.

Caution

- ⚠ Handle the camera with care, supporting the body. Ensure that the main electronics and components are not damaged. Do not hold the camera by the cable bundle. Only transport, store and install in suitable environments.
- ⚠ For security reasons, you must change the camera's default password. Ensure each camera has a unique IP address.
- ⚠ Using the incorrect voltage or two power supplies at the same time can damage the camera. Ensure the correct voltage is used.
- ⚠ Do not aim the camera at strong light such as sunlight or electric lighting.
- ⚠ Ensure that you install the network cable in a location where it will not be trampled or crushed.
- ⚠ Incorrect installation may result in water ingress into the camera. Ensure you install the camera correctly to ensure the unit is watertight.
- ⚠ Cameras powered by PoE have been evaluated as network environment "0" (basic insulation) and are not intended for routing outside a common building. Cable runs for cameras should only be run within a common building.

1. POWERING UP THE CAMERA



The fixing tape, lens cap and packaging foam must be removed prior to powering up the camera.


The camera can be powered by either an auxiliary power supply or PoE+ and is compliant with the IEEE 802.3at standard.

The camera can be powered by the following:

- Power over Ethernet (PoE+) switch
- PoE+ injector/midspan
- Auxiliary power supply
 - 24V AC - Camera has a maximum power usage of 43W

The camera should only be powered from the specified voltage.

A suitable power supply can be ordered separately (Part numbers: High PoE Injector 75W 130176).



2. CONFIGURING THE CAMERA

Configure the settings



By default, the camera uses a DHCP server.

- For more information, refer to the [Web Configuration Guide](#) for this camera.

1. Connect the camera to a PC using an Ethernet cable.
2. Navigate to the camera's default IP address using a web browser and set a secure password.
If the default password is required, enter 1234.
- If you cannot connect to a DHCP server, enter the default network settings.

3. Enter the NTP server and port on the **Setup > System > General > Date & Time** page.
4. Select the video standard for your region using the **Video Standard** option on the **Setup > System > General > General** page.
Choose **PAL** for countries with 50Hz power frequency and **NTSC** for countries with 60Hz power frequency.
5. Enter a new IP address and subnet mask on the **Setup > Network > TCIP/IP** page.

Further configuration

After the IP address has been configured, you can also access the camera's configuration pages through IndigoVision Control Center.

1. In **Setup** view, select the camera you want to configure.
2. Select the **Configure** tab, and enter a valid user name and password if required.

Binary I/O connections

The HD Ultra PTZ camera has seven binary inputs and two binary outputs. These are connected using the Alarm IO connections on the camera (Table 1).

Binary inputs

Binary inputs are operated by connecting the Input directly to GND.

The input must be configured on the web configuration pages to ensure correct behavior.

Binary outputs

The binary output is a solid state open collector output:

- Max load voltage: 20V DC
- Max current carrying capacity: 1A

The binary output is not polarity sensitive and is normally open. This can be configured on the web configuration pages.

3. INSTALLATION

Fixing the mount

The HD Ultra PTZ camera can be fixed in place using a variety of different mounting arrangements. These can be ordered separately.

4. OPERATIONS

Installing the Micro SD card




There is limited access to the Micro SD card slot. When inserting the Micro SD card use caution and ensure you do not drop the Micro SD card into the camera housing.

1. Ensure the device is switched off.
2. Undo the 4 dome screws (8) and remove the dome (9).
3. Insert Micro SD card into the slot (10)
4. Place the camera dome (9) back over the device and tighten the 4 dome screws.



Ensure that the seal on the dome is fitted correctly before tightening down the dome. Use a cross pattern when tightening. A poorly fitted dome will impact the IP rating of the camera.



Reset to factory defaults

You can reset the camera settings to factory defaults using the following methods:

Firmware factory restore

Click the **Full Restore** button on the **Setup > System > Default** pages.

Hardware factory restore

1. Remove the dome and locate the **Reset** switch (11).
2. Press the **Reset** switch and hold it for 10 seconds.

The camera will revert to the default factory settings.

If you have lost access to the camera web configuration pages and need to hardware factory restore while the camera is in motion, do the following:

1. Power off the camera.
2. While pressing the **Reset** switch (11), power up the camera and continue to hold the **Reset** switch for 40 seconds.
3. When you release the **Reset** switch (11), the camera begins its homing routine and factory reset procedure.

The camera will revert to the default factory settings.
