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



CONNECTIONS**SAFETY NOTICES****Warning**

- ⚠ Ensure the power supply is switched off, or that PoE power is disabled, during installation.
- ⚠ A falling camera can cause injury. During installation ensure the mount is attached securely to the surface and that the camera is attached securely to the mount.
- ⚠ Do not dismantle the device or attempt repairs yourself. Repairs must be done by IndigoVision representatives.
- ⚠ Ensure that the power supply conforms to the SELV (Safety Extra Low Voltage) safe level.
- ⚠ Risk of explosion if battery is replaced by an incorrect type. Dispose of used batteries according to the instructions.

Caution

- ⚠ Handle the camera with care, supporting the body. Ensure that the main electronics and components are not damaged. Only transport, store and install in suitable environments.
- ⚠ For security reasons, you must change the camera's default password. Ensure each camera has a unique IP address.
- ⚠ Using the incorrect voltage or two power supplies at the same time can damage the camera. Ensure the correct voltage is used.
- ⚠ Do not aim the camera at strong light such as sunlight or electric lighting.
- ⚠ Ensure that you install the network cable in a location where it will not be trampled or crushed.
- ⚠ Incorrect installation may result in water ingress into the camera. Ensure you install the camera correctly to ensure the unit is watertight.
- ⚠ Cameras powered by PoE have been evaluated as network environment "0" (basic insulation) and are not intended for routing outside a common building. Cable runs for cameras should only be run within a common building.
- ⚠ This product is intended to be supplied by a Listed Power Supply Unit marked "Class 2" or "LPS" and rated from 12 Vdc, 1A.
- ⚠ The wired LAN hub providing power over the Ethernet (PoE) in accordance with IEEE 802-3af shall be a UL Listed device with the output evaluated as a Limited Power Source as defined in UL60950-1.

- ⚠ Assurer que l'alimentation électrique est déconnectée ou que l'alimentation du PoE est désactivée pendant l'installation. Une caméra qui tombe peut entraîner des blessures corporelles. 1. POWERING UP THE CAMERA



There are 2 pieces of protective film which must be removed prior to powering up the camera.
One under the dome lid and the other around the lens module.


The camera can be powered by either an auxiliary power supply or PoE and is compliant with the IEEE 802.3af standard.

The following may be used:

- Power over Ethernet (PoE) switch
- PoE injector/midspan
- Auxiliary power supply
 - 12V DC – Camera has a maximum power usage of 7.5W (0.63A)

The camera should only be powered from the specified voltage.

A suitable power supply can be ordered separately (Part numbers: High PoE Injector 75W 130176, auxiliary 12V DC power supply 110068).



2. CONFIGURING THE CAMERA

Configure the settings



By default, the camera uses a DHCP server.

- ▶ For more information, refer to the Web Configuration Guide for this camera.

1. Connect the camera to a PC using an Ethernet cable.
2. Navigate to the camera's default IP address using a web browser and set a secure password.

If the default password is required, enter 1234.

If you cannot connect to a DHCP server, enter the default network settings.

3. Enter the NTP details on the **Setup > System > Date & Time Settings** page.
4. Enter a new IP address and subnet mask on the **Setup > Network > Network Settings** page.

Further configuration

After the IP address has been configured, you can also access the camera's configuration pages through IndigoVision Control Center.

Alternatively, you can access these pages through IndigoVision Control Center.

1. In **Setup** view, select the camera you want to configure.
2. Select the **Configure** tab, and enter a valid user name and password if required.

Alarm I/O connections

The HD Ultra X External Minidome has one alarm input and one alarm output. These are connected using the Alarm IO connections on the camera.

Alarm inputs


Alarm inputs are operated by connecting the alarm input + to alarm input -.

Inputs must be configured on the Web Configuration pages to ensure correct behavior.

Alarm output

The alarm output is a solid state open collector output:

- Max load voltage: 24V DC
- Max current carrying capacity: 50mA



Notice

Only use the cable to pierce the grommet. Do not use any other tools, for example, a screwdriver or scalpel. Ensure all cables have a round cross-section.

3. Secure the base housing (5) to the mounting plate (8) using the retaining screws in the base housing (5).
4. Connect the required cables to the camera assembly (3). Ensure the RJ45 connector does not have a strain relief molding or boot.
5. Secure the camera assembly (3) to the base housing (5).

Monitoring video during installation

To ensure the camera is aligned correctly you can view the camera picture during installation.


1. Connect the camera to a monitoring device using the supplied BNC Adapter cable connected into the video output port (11).



BNC analog output is only available when channel 2 resolution is 704x576 (4SIF) or lower.

4. OPERATIONS

Micro SD Card Installation



1. Ensure the device is switched off.
2. Undo the 4 camera screws (2) and open the camera dome (1).
3. Insert the Micro SD card into the slot (10).
4. Place the camera dome back over the device and tighten the 4 camera screws.

3. INSTALLATION

Fit the mounting plate

1. Use the mounting plate (8) as a template to mark out the fixing holes and cable access point on the mounting surface.
2. Prepare the holes and make the cutout on the mounting surface, fitting appropriate mounting plugs.
3. Secure the mounting plate (8) to the surface.

Fit the camera to the mounting plate

The base housing (5) provides two cabling options:

- 3/4" NPT threaded side cable exit hole (7)
- Three rear cable exit holes (6)

Before fitting the camera, ensure the exit holes are sealed using the blanking plug or grommets provided. The grommets must not be pierced.

1. Undo the 4 camera screws (2) and the camera dome (1).
2. Run the cabling through the exit hole (7) on the side or the exit holes (6) on the base of the base housing (5).

To run the cabling through the exit holes (6) on the base, follow these steps:

- a. Push the cable through the grommet.
- b. Ensure you have enough cable pushed through for camera connections.
- c. Draw the cable back to invert the center of the grommet and create a watertight seal.

Positioning the lens



Do not touch the camera dome or lens directly as this may cause damage. Clean with a soft dry cloth or mild cleaning solution.

1. Rotate the camera base to angle the camera towards the required area.
2. Carefully adjust the lens to ensure the image is the correct orientation.
3. Loosen the two locking screws on either side of the lens.
4. Tilt the lens vertically to the required position.
5. Tighten the locking screws.
6. Place the camera dome (1) back over the device and tighten the 4 camera screws (2).

Focus the camera

To focus the camera, click the **Auto** or **Manual Focus Mode** button on the **Main** page.

Reset to factory defaults

You can reset the camera settings to factory defaults using the following methods:

Firmware factory restore

Using the camera configuration pages, click **Setup > System > Factory reset > All**.

Hardware factory restore

1. Remove the dome and locate the Reset switch (9).
2. Press the Reset switch and hold it for 10 seconds.

The camera will revert to the default factory settings.
